

APSIPA Industrial Distinguished Leader (DL)

Nomination Guideline

1. DL Program

- (a) The APSIPA Industrial Distinguished Leader is a distinction reserved for selected APSIPA members (or potential members) whose extraordinary accomplishments in any of the fields related to APSIPA scope are deemed fitting of this prestigious recognition
- (b) The Distinguished Leaders are candidates to be elected into APSIPA Fellow Program, which is the highest honor in this community that will be established in year 2016 or later

2. Requirement for Distinguished Leader Nomination

- (a) A recognized industrial executive who has accomplishments that have contributed significantly to the advancement or application of engineering, science and technology, bringing the realization of significant value to the field
- (b) Have contributed a position paper (as a co-author) to an APSIPA Industrial Publication (e.g., APSIPA Transaction of Signal and Information Processing, published by Cambridge Press), or delivered a position talk at the APSIPA Industrial Forum in the past 12 months or within six months from the time of nomination.

3. A nominator's responsibility

The nominator is responsible for:

- Preparing the APSIPA Industrial Distinguished Leader Nomination Form, making sure all information is current and the form filled out correctly.
- Soliciting at least one, but no more than three, references capable of assessing the nominee's contributions.

4. Selection process

The nominees are discussed and voted within each Industrial Committee; Selected candidates are recommended to the Industrial Governance Board for final approval.

The nomination/selection process are conducted twice a year. An Award Certification will be mailed to the elected Distinguished Leaders.
